Phonics

We are continuing to use Little Wandle to teach phonics. The children will continue to learn new sounds and practise blending words together through listening games. They will be using magnetic letters to make CVC words listening to the sounds they can hear at the start middle and end. We will continue reading time on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. The children will then bring their new book to read at home on a Wednesday.

Number Time

- It's me 1,2,3. Count, make and subitise numbers to 3. Find 1 more, 1 less.
- Identify name and compare Circle and Triangles and shapes with 4 sides.
- Numbers to 5. Count, make and subitise numbers to 3. Find 1 more, 1 less.

- Make Potato print and wool poppies.
- Make party decorations and cakes.
- Explore Artist Jackson Pollock to develop fine motor skills.
- Make Christmas cards and crafts.
- Learn new songs for Christmas performance.
