English - we will complete this unit of work.

Years 3 & 4

Written responses to The Wild Robot:

Persuasive Writing (non-fiction): a book review persuading others to read the story.

Formal letter (non-fiction): a letter to the author of The Wild Robot.

Narrative (fiction): plan and write a sequel to the story.



Spelling - Please see your child's Spelling Journal for details of spelling work. **We will continue to have a spelling check every Thursday. Most children will still benefit from adult support to help them remember to practise and learn their spellings.** Doodle Spelling can be used to practise general spelling skills.

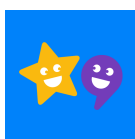
Grammar and Punctuation - children will continue to have a discrete grammar and punctuation teaching within their English lessons, with teaching points being reinforced throughout the curriculum.

Handwriting - children will continue to have regular handwriting sessions.

Reading

Please continue to listen to your child read **regularly** (3 - 4 times a week) at home. Children who are reading independently still benefit from opportunities to discuss their reading and should be encouraged to ask for the meanings of new words they encounter. Please record reading sessions and tricky words in your child's reading record book.



Doodle English

Your child will be set assignments on Doodle English each week. Please encourage your child to complete their assignments each week.

- Compare capacity and volume
- Add and subtract capacity and volume



Doodle Maths

Your child's maths homework will be set as assignments on Doodle Maths each week. Please make sure your child completes their assignments to ensure they are practising and revising key knowledge and skills.



Times Tables

Children will continue to learn their times tables at their own pace. They have resources in their Times Tables Folder in their book bag and can also use their white book to practise. Doodle Tables can also be used. We have a times table check every Friday. **Most children will benefit from reminders to practise their times tables. Ideally, this should be for 10 minutes, 3 times a week.**

Year 4 children will regularly practise for their statutory Multiplication Tables Check in June. This will help them to get used to the speed of the check and inputting their answers using the iPad. The following website is useful if your child would like to practise at home.
