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### Year 1 - seven children

#### **Phonics**

### Writing

Six of the seven children (86%) are working at the expected standard in writing. One child (14%) is working towards.

### <u>Science</u>

Six of the seven children (86%) are working at the expected standard in science. One child (14%) is working towards.

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### Year 2 - ten children

## **Phonics**

The two children who had to retake the phonics test both passed.

### **SATS and Teacher Assessment**

#### Maths

Six out of the ten children reached the scaled score of 100 and above, they are all achieving the expected standard. One child achieved 99, due to the reading aspect of the paper, not maths ability. During moderation this child was discussed and it is fair to consider them to have achieved the expected standard in maths.

Two children (20%) achieved the score of 87, working towards the expected standard. One child (10%) is worked at greater depth standard.

# **English**

### Reading

Seven out of ten children (70%) achieved the scaled score of 100 or above for reading. The three children (30%) that did not, have made progress this year. They are on our special needs register and they receive additional support wherever possible.

### Writing

Seven out of ten children (70%) are achieving the expected standard for writing.

### <u>Science</u>

In science, eight out of ten children (80%), are working at the expected standard. Two children (20%) are working towards the expected standard.

# **English**

### Reading

Seven out of ten children (70%) achieved the expected standard in reading.

One child (10%) is working towards, this child is on the SEN register and receives intervention.

Two out of the ten children (20%) have achieved greater depth in reading.

#### Writing

Seven out of ten children (70%) have achieved the expected standard.

Two children (20%) are working towards, both of these children are on the SEN register and receive interventions.

One child (10%) has achieved greater depth.

## <u>Science</u>

Nine out of ten children (90%) have achieved the expected standard in science.

One child (10%) is working towards in science.
