

**History**

**Stone Age to Iron Age.**



Children will learn about prehistory and early people. They will learn how archaeologists piece together information from the past and how life changed over thousands of years.

They will develop their understanding of chronology and begin to understand how things change over time.

**Prehistory timeline** →



**Art**

Work will be linked to and inspired by our History topic.

The children will learn about The Lion Man of the Hohlenstein Stadel and create their own sculptures.

They will learn about cave art and try to work out how early people created it.



We will also be enjoying Christmas art activities.

**Music**

**Chilled out clap rap**

This unit is built around a laid-back rap with accompanying clapping patterns and plenty of dynamic contrast. It offers opportunities for physical and creative activities that will help children develop their understanding of beat and rhythm.

Children will have a lesson with Mr Brown once a fortnight, when they will learn to play the ukulele and sing a range of songs.

## PSHE

### KS1 - Relationships - Digital Wellbeing

Children will learn how we can use the Internet in a safe and responsible way. They will discuss how the Internet can be useful in our everyday lives and how we can balance time online with doing other activities to keep our mind and body healthy. Children will consider what risks there are online and how we can make sure we stay safe, including how important it is to not share any personal information over the Internet. This unit will also explore the importance of communicating online in a way that shows kindness and respect and discuss whether or not we can believe everything we see on the Internet.

### KS2 - Relationships - VIPs

This unit will focus on relationships we have with our VIPs. It will look at friendships, how friendships are formed and maintained, and the qualities of a good friend. The lessons will then move on to disputes and bullying and will address strategies for coping with each of these.

## Computing

All of the children will have the opportunity to use our new laptops.

### KS1 - Digital Photography

The children will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos. Finally, they will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.



### KS2 - Creating Media - Audio Production (continued)

Children will discuss the ownership of digital audio and the copyright implications of duplicating the work of others. Using our new laptops and headsets, the children will use Audacity to produce a podcast, which will include editing their work, adding multiple tracks, and opening and saving the audio files. Finally, learners will evaluate their work and give feedback to their peers.

## PE

This half term, the children will develop their dance skills with specialist PE teacher, Mrs Lee-Turner.

We will also attend a skipping festival at the Wentworth Centre.

## Design Technology

Children will develop and use their knowledge of, and skills in, a variety of sewing techniques for joining and decorating fabric in order to design and make their own felt Christmas decoration.
