Art and Design Sculpture & 3D: Abstract shape

Children will learn how to transform 2D card shapes into three-dimensional structures and sculptures. They will explore abstract shapes and space, develop skills in constructing 3D objects, and understand the difference between 2D and 3D art.




Music

Children will have a lesson with Mr Brown once a fortnight.

Science

Children will learn about **Electricity** in their weekly Science lesson with Ms Nichols. Children will construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers.



They will learn how switches are used to open and close a circuit and recognise some common

conductors and insulators, and associate metals with being good conductors.
