Welcome to the Spring Term!

Here is an outline of Maths and English work for Year 2 next half term.

English

All About Animals - non-chronological report.

Children will read a non-chronological report about animals around the world written by Dan Smith. They will learn the features of a non-chronological report and will organise information using the subheadings in the text. They will learn the spelling rules used when adding the suffixes -er and -est and how these can be added to adjectives to create comparatives and superlatives. Children will explore statements, questions and exclamations and practise writing different sentence types. Children will apply their knowledge and writing skills to write their own non-chronological report about animals around the world.

Maths

Measurement: Money

- Count money in pence and pounds.
- Recognise and count amounts in coins and notes.
- Select money to make an amount.
- Find different ways to make the same amount.
- Find totals and differences.
- Give change.
- Solve simple two-step problems in practical ways.

Number: Multiplication and Division

- Recognise, make and add equal groups.
- Multiplication sentences from pictures and using the x symbol.
- Make and use arrays.
- recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.
