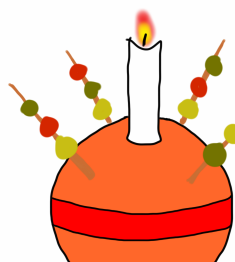


Flu Vaccinations - 13th December

Chollerton Pre-School Christmas Performance - December 6th - 6pm

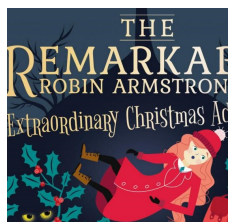
Please come along and see the wonderful performance by the Pre-School children. Barrasford Village Hall.
