This term the children are learning about gymnastics.

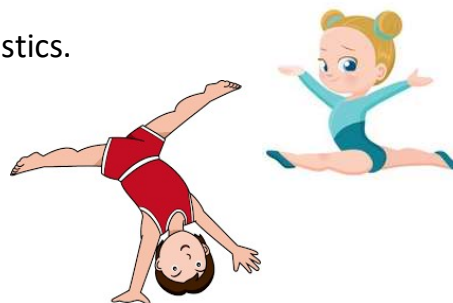
