Age:

The current Year 1 group is the largest in school with a cohort of 9 pupils.

The smallest group is Year 4 with a cohort of 6.

Currently the school population comprises of:

- 12 girls
- 26 boys

Reception and Year 1 are taught together in Class 1 (17 children)

Years 2, 3 and 4 are taught together in Class 2 (21 children)

The staff profile is of established, mature staff who have a long relationship with the school.

Disability

None of the pupils on roll currently have a significant physical disability.
