## Light in the darkness.

We will learn about the significance of light, both in Christianity and other faiths by exploring Diwali, Advent and Hanukkah. We will learn about the first Christmas and how Christians celebrate the birth of Christ.

## Geography

## KS1 Map Makers

The children will learn all about maps and the geography of the surrounding area. They will find out why we use maps and how to read them, as well as having the opportunity to draw their own maps and plan perspectives.

## KS2 Volcanoes

Children will learn where in the world volcanoes are found before looking at how and why volcanoes erupt. They will explore the positive and negative impact of eruptions on the environment by looking at two volcanic areas in detail, and investigating the flora and fauna that inhabit these areas.
At the end of the topic, we will return to our work on Italy to find out more about Pompeii and Mount Vesuvius.

Poppies
The children will learn about the significance of the poppy as a symbol of remembrance.
