Welcome to the Spring Term. Happy New Year to you all!

Our topic this term is Materials

In <u>Communication</u>, <u>Language and Literacy</u> we will describe objects: what they are made from; what we use them for; whether they are hard, soft, rough, smooth, etc.

We will write simple riddles giving two or three clues for an object.

We are going to do character studies using <u>Dora the Storer</u>. Our sound work continues. Please look for objects which begin with the letter of the week - in your child's reading folder on a Thursday.

In <u>Maths and Number</u>, we are looking at teen numbers: one set of ten and one makes 11; 1 set of ten and 2 makes 12, and so on to 20. We will count, order and make sets of teen numbers.

We are working on addition and subtraction: 1 more, 2 more, 1 less, 2 less to create new numbers.

We are also working on number bonds to 10 and on addition patterns, e.g. 4+0=4, 3+1=4, 2+2=4, 1+3=4, 0+4=4

In <u>Shape, Space and Measures</u> our Maths topic is $\underline{\text{time}}$.

Please talk about night, day, morning, afternoon, midday, days of the week. We will sequence events: first, second, third, through to last.

We look at a clock face and read o'clock and half past time.

<u>In Understanding the World</u> - the World, we are sorting objects - looking at the materials that objects are made from. We will look at the properties of materials, e.g. wood - natural not man made, can be changed, floats, strong, etc.

Please look around your home and talk about different materials - wood, metal, clay, wool and plastic.

In <u>People & Communities</u> our theme is friendship: why friends are important to us. Friends of Jesus. Also, looking after possessions, giving and receiving, charity and returning lost items.

In **Technology** we will use Ipads to photograph a wall.

We will create posters for our café using an art package on the computer. We will use 2 simple software for word-processing.

In <u>Expressive Arts & Design</u>, the children will make a model table using a variety of materials.

We will make observations of a stone wall, collecting information using the Ipads, then make chalk drawings and recreate a section of wall using clay.

We will be creating cakes - 3D and 2D - for our café using pastels and collage materials.

In <u>Music</u> we are singing a variety of songs and we are thinking about pitch - high and low notes.

Physical Development

Materials

We will do gymnastics using large apparatus to climb, slide and move safely.

It is <u>swimming</u> this half term.

Please continue with reading practice. The children will now have the opportunity to change the reading scheme books on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday and read to an adult in school. We will <u>no longer</u> do personal reading books (the large red book with word cards. You can keep these at home).
